Bumblebees are important pollinators since they are active from 6°C!

Diversified flower strips provide pollen continuously throughout the year.




30% of bees nest **in cavities** (tree trunks, bushes...)



70% of bees nest **in the ground** (old burrows, small holes dug...)

Running water points hydrate bees and are useful for nest construction.



Non ploughed area provide nesting **space** for bees.
