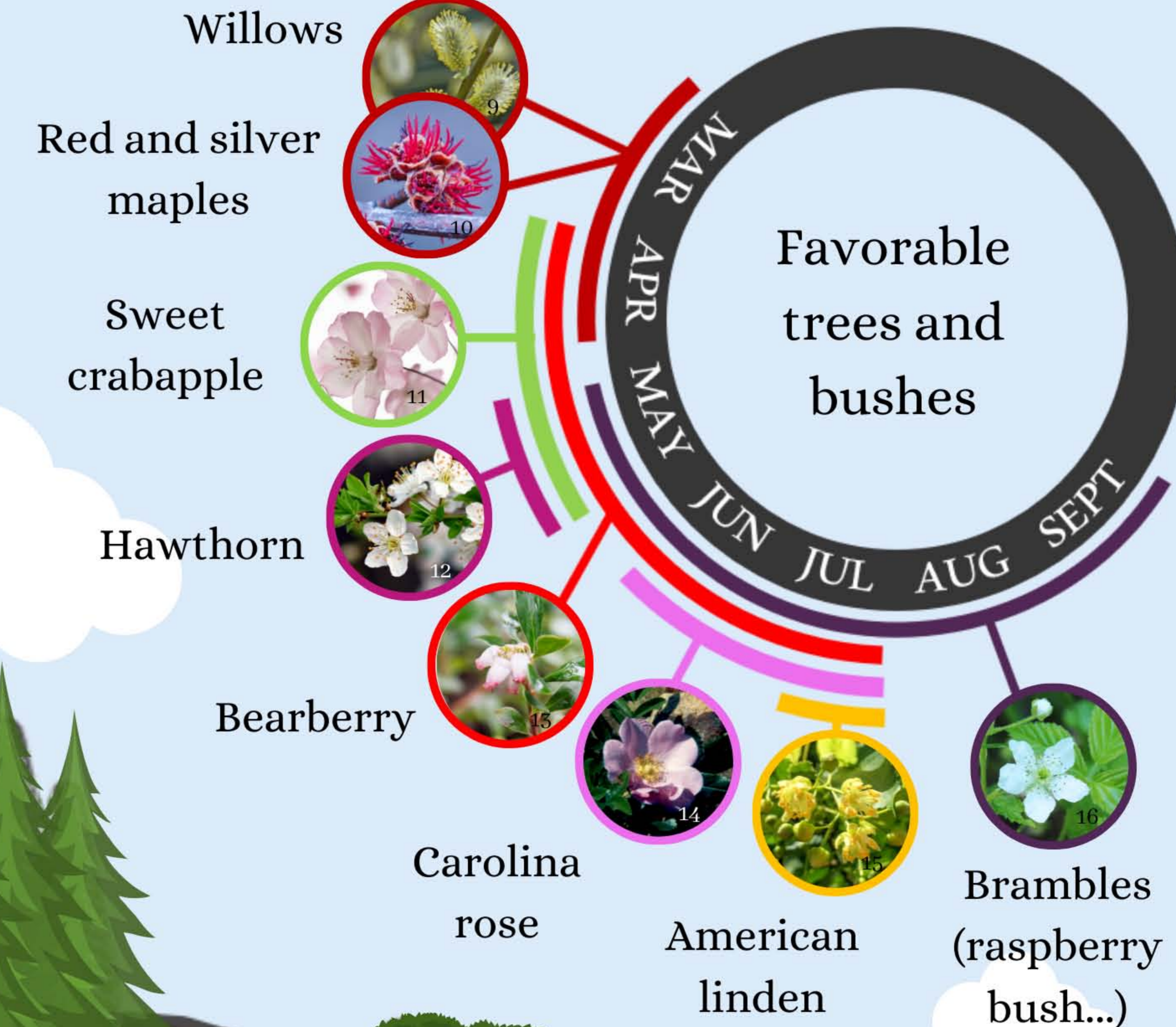


More than **800 bee species** are native to Canada, including 350 to 400 in Quebec and Ontario. The **honey bee** is not one of them! Important for humans, it can be a competitor of native pollinators.

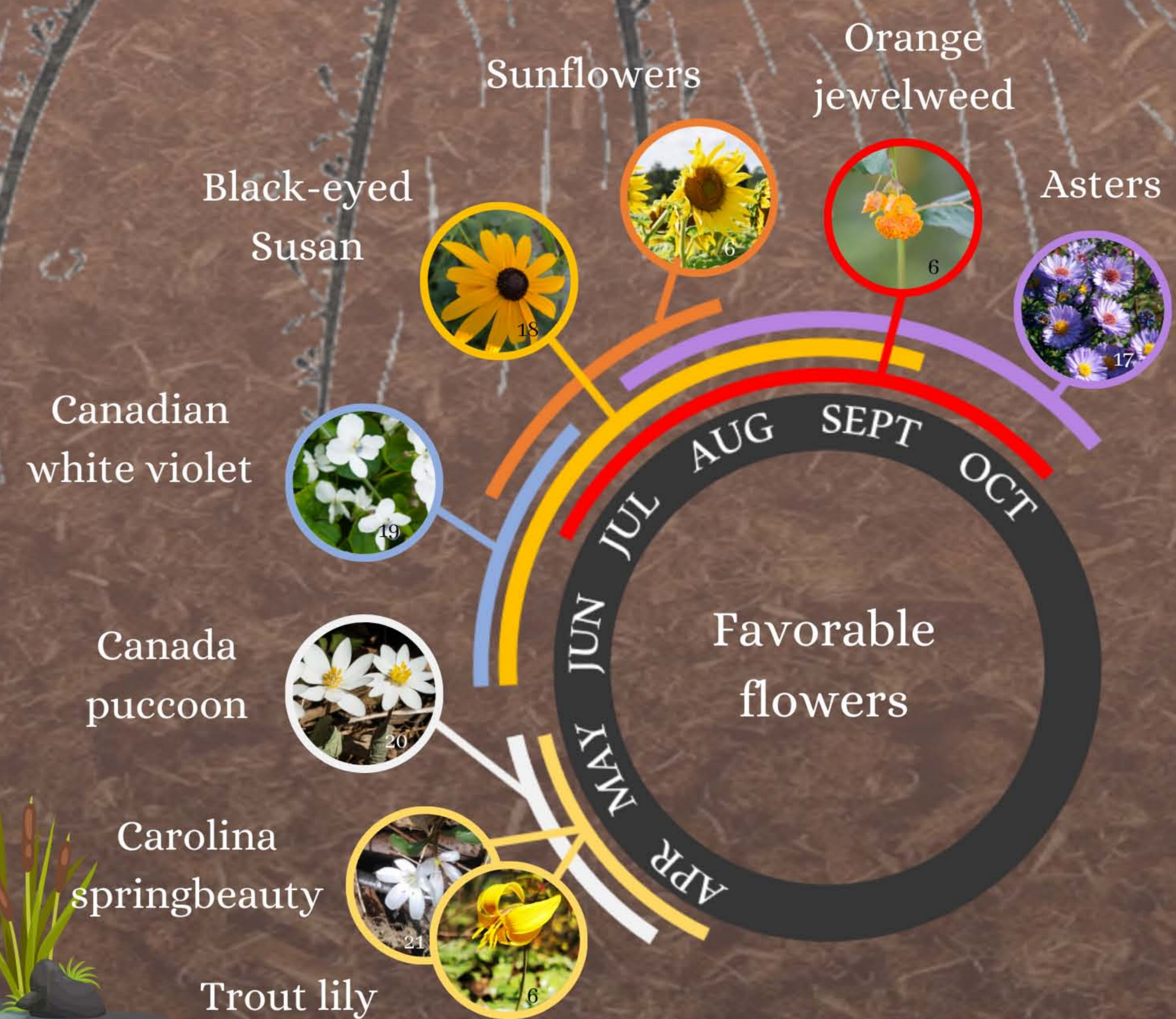
**Natural windbreaker hedges** are favorable habitats for pollinators

**30% of bees nest in cavities** (tree trunks, bushes...)

**Unploughed area** provide nesting habitats for bees

**70% of bees nest in the ground** (old burrows, small holes dug...)

**Running water** hydrates bees and is useful for nest construction
